

# The Problems Caused When Students are Underprepared

Lack of Academic Success in Higher Education When students are placed into remedial courses:

It causes undue financial burden

40% don't pass these courses and have to repeat the course or stop taking classes altogether


# Reading

#### Reading Challenges



#### Comprehension

Difficulty in understanding the meaning of text.



#### **Phonics Skills**

Limited phonics skills.



#### Vocabulary

Insufficient word recognition.



#### **Reading Rates**

Laborious reading rates.

#### **Focus on Reading**



#### READ, READ, READ

Novels, graphic novels, magazines, etc



#### **WORD GROUPS**

Chunk words or read in word groups



# Critical Thinking Skills

Promote discussion, questioning, interpretation, evaluation



#### **VOCABULARY**

Word recognition, phonics, context clues, and word analysis



#### **ANNOTATING SKILLS**

Actively engaged with text



#### **COMPREHENSION**

Deeper understanding of written text

#### **6 Active Reading Strategies**

#### **Visualize**

Use the details
 from the text to
 create a "movie"
 in their mind.

#### Clarify

- STOP, PAYATTENTION, andCHECK FORUNDERSTANDING
- Summarize
- Reread

#### Question

- Ask questions about the text.
- What are you confused about?
- What motivates the characters?
- Why is this happening?

#### **6 Active Reading Strategies**

#### **Predict**

- Figure out what will happen next.
- How will this end?
- Clues in the story and prior knowledge.
- Read on

#### **Connect**

- SELF
  - Personal Experience
- WORLD
  - Current Events
- TEXT
  - Similar Story

#### **Evaluate**

- Form Opinions
  - During reading
  - After reading
- Develop Ideas
  - Characters
  - Events


